SUBMISSION OF REGULAR PAPERS:

Prospective authors are invited to submit their papers by uploading them to the evaluation web site at: <u>www.icehtm.net</u>

Submissions must be uploaded by June 30, 2013 and must be in either MS doc or pdf formats (about 12-15 pages including all figures, tables, and references - single space, Time New Roman font size of 12). All reasonable typesetting formats are acceptable (later, the authors of accepted papers will be asked to follow a particular typesetting format to prepare their final papers for publication)

The first page of the paper should include: title of the paper, name, affiliation, postal address, and email address for each author. The first page should also identify the name of the Contact Author and a maximum of 5-6 topical keywords that would best represent the content of the paper. The name of the conference (i.e., ICEHTM) must also be stated on the first page of the paper as well as a 250-word abstract. The length of the final/Camera-Ready papers (if accepted) will be limited to 15 pages.

Each paper will be peer-reviewed by two experts in the field for originality, significance, clarity, impact, and soundness. In cases of contradictory recommendations, a member of the conference program committee would be charged to make the final decision (accept/reject); often, this would involve seeking help from additional referees. Papers whose authors include a member of the conference program committee will be evaluated using the double-blinded review process.

SUBMISSION OF POSTER PAPERS:

Poster papers can be 2 pages long. Authors are to follow the same instructions that appear above (see, SUBMISSION OF REGULAR PAPERS) except for the submission is limited to 2 pages. On the first page, the author should state that "This paper is being submitted as a poster". Poster papers (if accepted) will be published if and only the author of the accepted paper wishes to do so.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

ICEHTM 2013 is an international conference, aims at sharing knowledge, practices and expertise in the fields of e-Health and Telemedicine, and at the same time have the way for more inter-institutional collaboration in research that would lead to better healthcare and health services, especially in poor countries in the Middle East and North Africa.
